Fabrick Housing Group was created in 2008 by bringing together two successful Tees Valley based Registered Social Landlord (RSL) companies; Tees Valley Housing, a traditional housing association and Erimus Housing, formed from the large scale voluntary transfer of properties from Middlesbrough Council. Norcare, a Newcastle based charity providing supported housing services to vulnerable people, joined the Group in July 2012.

This Framework is being let to complement and not compete with the existing GPS PSN national framework. It offers access to solutions to requirements that do not need to be PSN accredited, thereby reducing the potential for inbuilt cost. It also addresses some specific specialist needs not readily identified within the offering in the GPS PSN contract.

GPS PSN contract.
Equally important, because it does not specifically require PSN accredited suppliers, it offers an opportunity for SMEs to bid and potentially win access to Public Sector business. This is totally in keeping with the Government's expressed requirement to open up public sector business to small businesses in general, and those not able to compete for business offered through the GPS PSN framework in particular. Fabrick Housing Group (the Group) intends to award a Framework contract for Telecommunications and Networks Services for use by itself and other bodies in the Public Sector with particular attention to meeting the specific needs of the Registered Social Landlords' sector, and those of the Education Sector. The Framework contract will form the basis of the financial and contractual arrangements between each Public Sector Body using the Framework and the Service Providers nominated under it

using the Framework and the Service Providers nominated under it.

The nature of services available under the Framework is wide-ranging and is divided into Lots as described below. It is intended to nominate a minimum of 3 and maximum of 6 providers for each Lot, exceptionally these boundaries may be broached if it is deemed in the best interests of potential end users to ensure service provision or better value.

The framework agreement is let on behalf of Fabrick Housing Group, and the Framework Contract will be Contract Managed on their behalf by Dukefield. The tender is also available for Higher Education and Further Education institutions including members of the Crescent Purchasing Consortium and, as per their joint contracting programme, other bodies that could potentially be interested in accessing the agreement include various University Purchasing Consortia and British Museums.
